Player Code of Conduct

- Players will conduct themselves in such a manner that they bring credit and respect to their families, teammates, and the Rev Volleyball Academy. Anyone who willfully performs any act that is detrimental to themselves, their school, or Rev Volleyball shall be subject to discipline, suspension, or expulsion from the program.
- **DISCIPLINE:** Will mean any form of corrective action deemed necessary to correct the problem. Each player will be told what needs to be corrected and given a specific time frame in which to accomplish it. The player will be expected to participate in practices and travel to tournaments even though they may not play. If a player makes no attempt to correct a specific problem in the specific time frame, he/she may be suspended or expelled from the club.
- **SUSPENSION:** Will mean a suspension from participation in any team related activity for a specific number of days. A suspension is usually a last chance result of a disciplinary problem.
- **EXPULSION:** Will mean that the player will be denied the right to any future participation or privilege of the Rev Volleyball Academy. No refunds of any kind will be given in the case of an expulsion.
- Prior to the implementation of the above sanctions, a conference with the player will be conducted to ensure the player's understanding of the problem and its actions.
- The following acts shall constitute sufficient cause for implementing disciplinary actions. (List is not all-inclusive)
 - Disruptive or unsportsmanlike conduct
 - Excessive tardiness or unexcused absences
 - Disobedience or display of bad attitude towards coach
 - Excessive late payments
 - Not maintaining a grade point average above 2.5/4.0 scale during competition. (***Team average***)
 - Illegal transport, illegal possession, or use of illegal drugs or other substances banned by the RVA or USAV
 - Use of a recognized identification card by anyone other than the individual described on the card
 - Physical damage to a facility or theft of items from a room, dormitory, residence, or other person
 - Possession of fireworks, ammunition, firearms, or other weapons or any item or material which by commonly accepted practices and principles would be a hazard or harmful to other persons, state or local ordinances

- Violation of the specific policies, regulations, and/or procedures of the USA, USAV or the facility used in conjunction with a sanctioned event
- Conduct which is inappropriate as determined by comparison to normally accepted behavior Physical or verbal intimidation of any individual

Spectator / Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

IMPORTANT NOTICE – IF YOU ENTER/ATTEND ANY HOOSIER REGION SANCTIONED EVENT, YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING CODE OF CONDUCT GUIDELINES:

I WILL:

- I WILL abide by the official rules of USA Volleyball.
- I WILL display good sportsmanship at all times.
- I WILL encourage my child and his/her team, regardless of the outcome on the court.
- I WILL educate myself on the unique rules of this facility.
- I WILL honor the rules of the host and the host facility.
- I WILL generate goodwill by being polite and respectful to those around me at this event.
- I WILL direct my child to speak directly with his/her coach when coaching decisions are made that may be confusing or unclear.
- I WILL redirect any negative comments from others to the respective Event Director or Program Administrator.
- I WILL immediately notify the Event Director and/or Program Administrator in the event that I witness any illegal activity.
- I WILL support the policies and guidelines of the team/club that I represent.
- I WILL acknowledge effort and good performance, remembering that all of the players in this event are amateur players.
- I WILL model exemplary spectator behavior while attending this event.
- I WILL respect the history and tradition of the sport of volleyball by being a good ambassador.

I WILL NOT:

- I WILL NOT harass or intimidate the officials.
- I WILL NOT coach my child from the bleachers and/or sidelines.
- I WILL NOT criticize my child's coach or his/her teammates.
- I WILL NOT participate in any game or game-like activities unless I have a current membership card with the Hoosier Region.
- I WILL NOT bring and/or carry any firearms at any Hoosier Region event.

Note: Any violation of this Code of Conduct will result in you being asked to leave the site/facility, and may result in you possibly being banned from attending future Hoosier Region sanctioned events. The Event Director has the final say regarding their individual event. Local law enforcement will be contacted if necessary, to resolve any disputes or altercations. Questions or concerns may be directed to the Hoosier Region office.
